Her executive career spanned senior roles in chemicals and natural resources, including CEO of a listed public company. Her qualifications include Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Organic Chemistry, PhD in Physical Chemistry, Graduate Diploma in Technology Management, Master of Business Administration and Graduate of the Australian Institute of Company Directors' Company Directors Course. Dr Beeby is a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Technology and Engineering.
