Applications we won't consider:

- Initiatives outside of Tasmania.
- Provision of free or discounted electrical infrastructure, electricity, or any other core product.
- Initiatives with poor safety and/or environmental performance.
- Any project, event or organisations that could be inconsistent with our vision or role in the Tasmanian community.
- Individual, or fundraising campaigns.
- For profit, or unincorporated entities.



Application tips

Don't underestimate the power of a strong application. Here are some tips to help you through the application process:

Support your application:

- Support your application
- Attach some examples of your initiative in action.
- Attach a video or image, if applicable.

Keep it simple:

- Be direct and to the point.
- Dot points are a good way to go.
- Stay relevant avoid unnecessary jargon.

Tell your organisation's story:

- Provide some background on your organisation and the work you do.
- Tell us why your project is important to the community?

Don't leave it to the last minute:

- Allow time to gather everything needed and to review your application.
- If you aren't sure about something, don't be afraid to ask.
