Procurement Update

TasNetworks intends to appoint a preferred Head Contractor in the coming months. The Request for Proposal (RFP) for design and construction of NWTD stage 1 closed in late May 2024, followed by commencement of proposal evaluation and negotiations. Appointing the successful Head Contractor to undertake the 'Early Contractor Involvement' (ECI) phase is a prerequisite to a Final Investment Decision for the project, scheduled for December 2024.

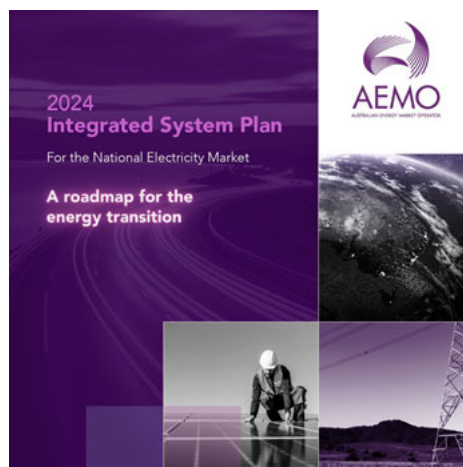
